Position Overview

The WAMASC Instructor's rating is awarded for demonstrated proficiency to Gold Wings standard, proven knowledge in instructional training as specified in the MAAA Instructor's Manual and knowledge of Rules and Regulations relating to the flying of model aircraft. In the case of Helicopter Instructor rating, the person must (a) successfully complete an MAAA Instructor's course including the additional flight-test or (b) complete the flight test if he/she originally undertook the course as a Fixed Wing Pilot.

Responsibilities and Duties

- To assist new members of the Club with flight training and final assessments to achieve the relevant wings qualification.
- To ensure students are complying with all relevant Flight Safety rules.
- To ensure their students complete the final written assessment prior to relevant wings flight test.
- Through contact with WAMASC C.F.I. monitor effectiveness of training programs.
- Organise a course syllabus, with liaison of the Club C.F.I., to assist in maintaining constant standards of courses throughout Australia.
- Act as catalyst for exchange of best practice and areas that can be improved.
- Recommend improvements to Flight Instruction and Wings Schemes.
- Updating changes/corrections to WAMASC Instructors Manual and Student Log Book.
- Ensure Pilot Log Books are completed by new pilots.
- Other related activities as required from time to time.

Knowledge and skills required

- Has a good working knowledge of the constitution, rules and the duties of all office holders and subcommittees
- Is a supportive leader for all organization's members
