The Club welcomes all new members but would like to make them aware that as the club is responsible for the maintenance of the airfield and maintaining good relations with neighbours we expect that all members will participate in activities related to the upkeep and improvement of the club facilities.

MEMBER

Dictionary entry overview: What does member mean?

- **MEMBER** (noun)

The noun **MEMBER** has 5 senses:

1. One of the persons who compose a social group (especially individuals who have joined and participates in a group organization).

The Club needs members to participate in activities to continue with the upkeep of the premises or events.

The below appears to be the best option for a Club of our size.



GOLD MEMBERSHIP

\$250 with commitment to sit on either a committee position or subcommittee position.
(This will require attendance at committee meetings / events / outside meetings)

There is a lot of work which takes place behind the scenes that enables the WA Model Aircraft State Centre to operate. To ensure we have an organised efficient club we require members to hold committee and subcommittee positions. Our annual general meeting will be coming up in the next few months and we ask you all to consider filling a committee or subcommittee position. For those who are willing to commit their time and fill a position a discounted membership fee is available. The \$50 will be refunded after the Election of office bearers at the Annual General Meeting. (usually August)

SILVER MEMBERSHIP

\$300 with commitment to assist at a Public event or Working bee

As we undertake whole of club events, and working bees, we are looking to have as many committed club members as possible. We encourage everyone to take advantage of the silver membership which is on offer. By undertaking to assist we ask that you make yourself available when events take place , for a minimum of 4 hours per year.

BRONZE MEMBERSHIP

\$350 with no requirement to assist at Public events or Working bees

With WAMASC being such a diverse club we understand that some of our members lead busy lives where they travel on a regular basis and find it hard to fit other things into their busy schedule. The bronze membership is designed for those who want to be a part of the club however are unable to give a firm commitment when it comes to assisting at events.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

\$50 as the junior membership is considerably subsidised we require all juniors to make a commitment when joining/renewing with the club that they assist at public events or working bees.

SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP

\$25 there is no requirement for Social members to participate in any Event, however your assistance is always greatly appreciated.

The Level of your membership is unknown to any other member, a general membership card is still utilised.

The Executive Committee / Events Organiser / Working Bee organiser will be the only Committee members able to access this information.

A register of a member's membership level will be maintained and members will be signed off once approved assistance to your club has been completed.



- Members who fail to comply with their Membership Level (Silver) will be charged the \$50 in their next renewal and will only be permitted to renew at the Bronze level.
- Sub Committee; canteen duties / control line coordinator / merchandise / newsletter / event's organiser / website / first aid officers / safety officer / instructors / as required.
- Duties during working bees, (or other organised days) will be varied to accommodate a person's abilities. It would be anticipated that you would offer at least 4 hours assistance to your Club.
